FAA Update –Doug Anderson gave an update on the FAA with Missouri staffing updates. A; fiscal year 2023 all AIP grants must be signed by 9/15/2023.

Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association – Tom Chandler gave the update. He helped with the aircraft insurance issue. Bob Stuart Scholarship Report – San Stallbauer reported the raise of the scholarship amount to \$2,000. This year we had 11 professional ad 2 technical applications.

State Aviation Day – Abe Forney reported that if we want to provide a meal at State Aviation Day we will need to find additional funding sources. He also spoke on issues with legislation, funding and other items.

UCM School of Aviation – Dan Dietz gave the report. Dr. Furedy has resigned as resigned as department chair and will return to teaching. The flight school has 4 new to them Cessna 172s, 1 Baron was replaced. They are working on getting an update on aircraft. Skyhaven received a \$850,000 grant from the state to put in a fuel farm. The MAMA Student Chapter attended an airshow in Nebraska. The Chapter is doing an Adopt A Highway project. They have airport visits scheduled. The new Aviation Center dedication is September 8 at 3 pm.

AAAE – Dave Schubert gave the report. Dave Schaumberg is the elected state representative. Ty Sander will be chairing the Corporate Committee.


MAMA 2024 Schedule – April 2 – State Aviation Day, April 3 – MoSAC Summit, April 4&5 – MAMA Conference.
