Minutes April 3, 2024

Katrin Amos, chair, called the meeting was to order. Attendees were introduced. Minutes of the MoSAC/MAMA Fall Meeting were approved as presented.

**Sponsors** – All sponsors thanked for their support of the conferences.

**Treasurer’s Report** – Marquita Pace, Secretary/Treasurer gave the report.

**Bob Stuart Scholarship** – We only had 3 applicants this year. We will work on getting the information out to different groups. This year’s recipient is Gabriel Epstein. He and his mother will be attending Thursday night banquet.

**Legislative Update** – Abe Forney gave the update. The federal and state are working well together on legislative issued. The Missouri House did 63 bills, 23 were perfected and sent to the Senate. 8 were perfected in the Senate. MoDOT is requesting 5 additional positions.

**AAAE Update** – Dave Schubert gave the update. He is the state representative for the Great Lakes Chapter. The National Conference is in Nashville. The Great Lakes Chapter Annual meeting is in Lexington, Kentucky in July.

**State Aviation Day** – Katrina Amos reported that 25 signed the attendance roster for State Aviation Day.

**Pre-Set Meters on Fuel Systems** – Glenn Balliew reported advances are being made. The FAA gave an opinion on their interpretation.

**Airport Solar Farm Installation on Airports** – Presentation by Robert Crain, Burns & McDonnell. The study involved a 30-year lease on 50 acres in Minnesota with 13,8=850 panels. He pointed out that you need to get fair-market value for the lease. A land release from federal obligation will need to be done. The analysis for the 50-acre site and glare study. The glare study showed that the glare was no more that you would have with a lake or parking lot. Things that need to be considered when doing Alease ore emergency access, maintenance of fencing, etc.


**Legislative Road Map** – Presentation by Ally Fields, CMT. She described the legislative process in detail.
